It is with great excitement that we are able to confirm the dates for the Stage 3 Excursion to Canberra this year. We will depart Coolamon on Wednesday 31st October, and return on Friday 2nd November 2018 (Week 3, Term 4). Full summer school uniform is to be worn each day of the excursion.

Meals

Students will need to bring a packed morning tea, afternoon tea and lunch in their back packs for Wednesday. All other meals, including packed lunches, are supplied by the Sundown Motel.

Transport

Transport will be provided by Allen's Coaches. We will travel in an air-conditioned coach with individual seat belts and a DVD player.

Cost

The total cost for the excursion is \$310.00 per student. Please note this cost includes all transport, meals (except those specified for the first day of travel) and entry into all venues and exhibitions. The cost does not include spending money. Should students wish to bring their own money to purchase extra food items or souvenirs, this is to be at their own expense. We recommend students bring no more than \$20-\$30 each. Each student is to be responsible for their money.

Payment

To ensure the excursion will go ahead we ask that you **pay a deposit of \$60.00 cash** before the 4th of June 2018 to secure venues and lock in our numbers of students attending. Should the excursion be cancelled due to lack of attendees, the \$60.00 will be refunded up until the 4th of June. After the 4th of June, if numbers are secured the \$60 will be non-refundable and you will be asked to pay the balance owing of \$250 (please see optional payment plan details below).

Payment for the Excursion is to be made as follows:

Thursday 30 August	\$100	
Monday 24 September	\$ 50	(final payment)

After the deposit has been paid in cash, the remainder of the payment may be paid in full by cash, EFTPOS, POP or Cheque made payable to Coolamon Central School. The remaining \$250 payment may be paid in full should you not wish to follow the payment plan.

Should you wish to organise an alternate payment plan, please make an appointment with Mr Beer at your earliest convenience. We would love to have all of Stage 3 attend.

Accommodation

Accommodation in Canberra is at the Sundown Motel - Narranbundah.

A packing requirement list will be sent home closer to our departure date. Students who have not made total payment by Friday 28th September will be unable to attend the Excursion.

Please complete the attached permission note, contract and medical information form and return it to your child's classroom teacher by Monday 30th May 2018.

Please note: After Friday 28th September 2018 (3 school weeks prior to the excursion) no refunds will be given if your child decides to withdraw from the excursion, as bookings will have been made at Canberra venues. In addition, your child can only attend this excursion when they have read and signed the attached compulsory code of conduct form and their behaviour does not require a risk assessment under our Discipline and Welfare Policy.
