#### Attendance

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- •being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- •exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7 day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record.




Vaccination cards for Years 7 and 10 have been sent home and need to be returned to the office by Friday 12th February 2020.

#### Morning & Afternoon Supervision

The School's supervision roster starts from 8.40am. There are no staff available to supervise students in the playground prior to this time.

Some families in our School who have working parents take turns to take each other's children to school.

#### **Medication for students at school**

If your child requires medication while at school, please follow the following steps:

ALL medication must be kept in the school office. **Parents** are to bring the medication in to the front office with a **signed** note explaining **what** medication, **how much** and **when** it is to be given. As per department regulations parents will be required to present Webster packs to the school office. Webster packs can be organised with your dispensing Chemist. If parents are unable to bring in the medication themselves, please ring to notify the school Principal. If you have any queries please contact the front office.
