Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)

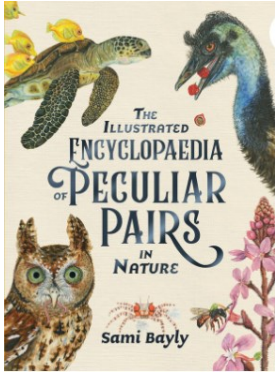
The PRC for this year closes this Friday, 19 August. Please make sure your online reading logs are up to date. If you need some last minute inspiration, we have a plethora of reading options available.

Going Shopping

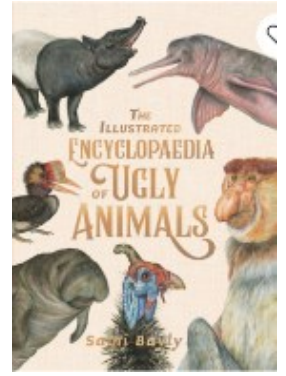
