## *from the Principal*

I would like to thank all of our students and parents for the patience they have shown with the new restrictions over the last few weeks. It is good to see the large number of students participating in their learning either online or using their booklets. Our staff have been working very hard to facilitate this learning.

From Monday May 11<sup>th</sup> Coolamon Central will be following the Department of Education guidelines in providing at least one day of face to face learning for all students. The following tables outline the program that the school will be following for Weeks 3 and 4. We have given preference to Years 11 & 12 due to the requirements for Stage 6 and the upcoming HSC. We have also allocated an extra day for Kindergarten because of the difficulties they face with home learning.

It is important that parents continue to follow social distancing when they come to collect student work. I would also like to ask parents to leave the grounds promptly when dropping off or picking up their children. The DoE has provided extra hours for our cleaning staff who will be cleaning surfaces in the playgrounds and toilets between recess and lunch. We also have additional supplies of hand sanitiser and soap so that we can all continue to practice good hygiene.

Our new Agriculture classroom is now complete and will provide an outstanding up to date learning centre when all of our students return to school.

## Attention Parents and Students

**We are really looking forward to getting students back** to school and hope the organisation on the following page suits your family dynamics.

Normal class timetables will run on these days.  
During weeks 3 - 4 students will be expected to **continue with remote learning packages and resources sent home**. Students on site or at home will be completing the same unit of learning  
Students must bring in all resources needed including laptops borrowed from school.

**Social distancing** procedures will be in place and students will need to take responsibility for this especially at recess and lunch times. Students will be encouraged not to touch or stand within 1.5 metres of each other. Students will be encouraged to wash hands during each break and sanitise their hands regularly.

The **School Canteen** will be open with a preference to take orders in the morning.

**Buses will run as usual** and the school day will run at normal times with bells starting the day at 9am and finishing at 3.10pm.

We will inform you of the plan **beyond week 4** as things become more certain.

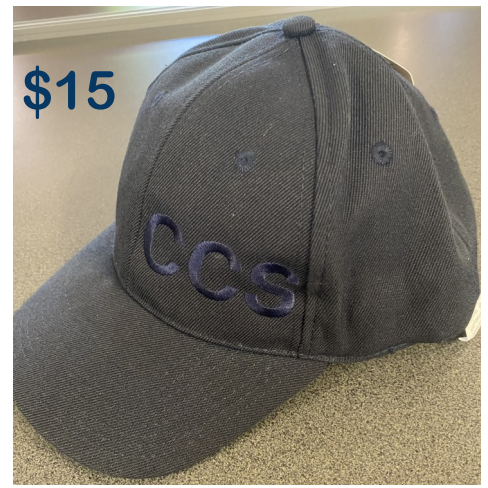
